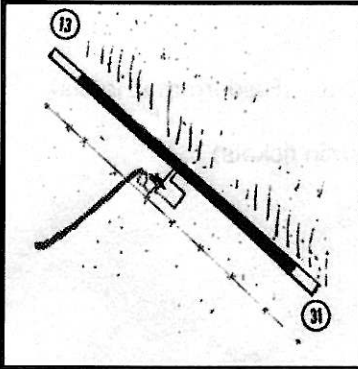

This is the starting point for the Baja Bush Pilots Copper Canyon trips. You fly in the night before so that you can be to the railroad station the next morning at 7:00 for the 7:30 train that comes in at 8:15.

To get to the train station, you will take the road to the airport and go about two more miles. Figure on about US\$5.00 for a taxi. There are always taxis at the station whenever a train is scheduled to come in. Tickets for passage can be purchased in a little shop just below the Hotel Posada del Hidalgo.

This is the home of the Hotel Posada del Hidalgo in the center of town. A must to see, even if you are not staying there, it was built originally as a private home and has been expanded now to the nicest and most historic hotel in el Fuerte.
