

# LIGA INTERNATIONAL Operational Checklist

## I. Flight to/from Mexico

1. Ensure that you have all the appropriate documents for the trip:
  - a) Passport
  - b) Mexican Flight Insurance
  - c) Mexican Flight Plan
  - d) Passenger Information
2. File flight plan with FSS with time, crossing point, passenger info and return info prior to crossing border.
3. Upon entering Mexican airspace ensure you are squawking the appropriate code and contact closest Mexican approach or tower for traffic advisories.
4. Upon arrival at the point of entry into Mexico:
  - a) Request fuel
  - b) Complete and sign Form G.H.C.-001 to request the appropriate authorization by Customs and Migration Departments.
  - c) Deliver Form G.H.C.-001 to the manager of the international airport in which the first arrival took place in order to obtain the relevant seal. The aircraft pilot shall keep the original of Form G.H.C.-001 aboard to produce it as required by the Aeronautics Authorities in other airports they use during their stay.
  - d) Deliver a copy of the insurance policy to the airport manager.
5. On return trip through point of entry in Mexico:
  - a) Request fuel
  - b) Complete and sign appropriate forms with the airport manager and Customs and Migration Departments.
6. When within 100 NM of U.S. border contact FSS and update border crossing time, location and passenger information from original flight plan.
7. Upon landing at U.S. point of entry, contact U.S. Customs and Immigration to pay entry fees.

## II. In-flight Procedures

1. Stay in contact with closest airport and note radial and DME distance for controller.
2. On the hour a roll call is taken to monitor progress of flight for safety. (see roll call log)
